What is it?

Wings College is a Devon County Council approved Post-16 alternative provision, offering functional skills in English & Mathematics, PSHE and a suite of City and Guilds employability short courses. Starting in Sept 2024 students are able to join the college on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday for the academic year to cover the whole curriculum.

Who is it for?

Those in need of alternative provision, with an EHCP or needing a supportive atmosphere to work in or for whom it is not possible to meet their needs in a mainstream college environment. Places are limited and can be commissioned by parents, DCC or direct from schools.

College Goals

Here at Wings we have a strong history of working with young people and we aim to work with all young people in a relaxed and friendly environment. This encourages the young people to try their best and work towards their future. Our purpose is to:

- Recognise young people's learning and social needs
- Adapt learning to the young person's needs
- Prepare young people for the next steps in their education/employment journey
- Focus on positive relationships with students, value them as individuals and work alongside them to build resilience, hope and self-worth
